





Recommended routes and locations




Entry procedure

Forbidden items

- Weapons and/or objects that can be used as a weapon
- Bottles or containers of any sort
- Pyrotechnics, smokebombs or fireworks of any sort
- Alcohol, drugs or any other illegal substances
- Flagpoles
- Flags, banners, posters or tifos not accepted by the club in advance
(Flags, banners, posters or tifos that are accepted must not contain the following but not exclusively: racist, political, commercial, sexual and/or containing messages that may upset the general public.
- Helmets
- Selfiesticks
- Laserpens
- Animals, except service animals agreed upon in advance
- Professional video equipment
- Balaclavas and/or similar clothing in the intent of covering your face for criminal intentions

Stadium Regulations

- The stadium is at all times monitored by CCTV.
- Anyone who refuses to be searched by security upon entry to the stadium will not be given access to the stadium. Ticket refunds will not be granted.
- Anyone who is decided to be too drunk and/or disorderly will not be given access to the stadium. Ticket refunds will not be granted.
- Anyone inside the stadium who is decided to be too drunk, disorderly or in any way bothering the general peace of the game will be removed.
- Anyone in the possession of pyrotechnics, alcohol, drugs or any illegal item according to Norwegian Law will be removed and handed over to the Police.
- Once you have entered the stadium, you are not allowed to leave and come back. Your ticket can only be scanned once.
- It is not allowed to smoke inside the stadium gates. However, we make exceptions for the away fans.
- Gathering and/or transferring and/or production and/or spreading of information or data concerning game-development, results, incidents, behaviour or other such matters during the game is strictly prohibited. Recording of sound, video or any audiovisual material during the game (using electronic or any other recording device) for use in any form of gambling, game or commercial activities not authorized in advance by the club is strictly prohibited. Breaking any of these terms and regulations will result in removal from the stadium and can involve the Police.
- The security staff and Police are here for everyone. If you have any questions and/or concerns, feel free to ask. We are nice people.
